3. Discussion
 - a. PGS survey – Results - Holley Shafer – PRIE: Holley’s comments follow about specific questions. The committee will discuss once we have the final copy.
 - Q1: Out of a total of 538 possible, 103 people responded. Holley felt that this was a pretty good (19.1%) response.
 - Q3 (Motivation): The majority of responses included wanting to be aware of the issues; wanting to be involved in decision-making; wanting to support PGS; and felt they could make a difference.
 - Q4: 38 had positive experiences; only 2 were somewhat negative. (no one – very negative)
 - Q5 (how have you benefited): Learned more, fostered relationships, heard other perspectives and felt more connected
 - Q6 (effectiveness of committee): the responses here included people who had not served on committees.
 - Q7 (last 3 years - experience on committees): Committee members noted that the color scheme with red being strongly agree sent a confusing message. But overall, the respondents

agreed or strongly agreed that meetings were respectful, organized, responsive, and an effective use of their time.

- Q10 (constituent members attendance): faculty and staff appear to have regularly attended; students mostly not; and for some reason managers are not listed.
- Q11 (participation by constituent groups): same comment as for Q10.
- Q12 (Qurum): 95% said it was met most of the time
- Q14 (reason not currently on PGS committee)
- Q15 (would you serve: resounding “maybe”).
- Q16 (areas interested in): not surprising that Student Access and Success and facilities received the highest responses.
- Q17 (meetings in person/zoom): flexibility – 77%; zoom 16.&%)
- Q18 (other committees): largest % - hiring committees
- Q8, Q9, Q13 – were all comments. GRC members will study these at the next meeting.
