 - o *Enter path:* Help student choose path and enter through h.s. outreach, and redesign and accelerate traditional remediation
 - Stay on path: Monitor progress, advise, and embed instructional and noninstructional support
 - Ensure learning: Establish and assess program-level learning outcomes, integrate applied learning experiences, and use effective teaching practices

Strong Workforce: Goal is to increase number of skilled workers produced by community colleges, particularly through increased regional planning and coordination, by identifying region's workforce demands and creating relevant curriculum to meet them.

 Adult Education Block Grant: Provides funds towards creating more comprehensive approach to adult education through development and coordination by regional consortia
