#### Clubs


1. No new clubs or modifications – we still have 22 clubs going strong.

- 5. October 10 Met with Vivlon support services to look at engaging their 74 new residents with ESCOM services.

- 7. October 16 ESCOM is helping to host a COM Trustee Candidate Forum for MC League of Women Voters.
- 8. October 18 ESCOM Spotlight on "2024 Election Propositions w MC League of Women Voters."

### News

- 1. ESCOM outreach has brought in 650 new members in the last 12 months for a total membership of 3200 members.
- 2. Five new trainers will be taking the Senior Planet Train-the-trainer online training in October; these new trainers will work with the ESCOM Digital Literacy Committee to offer in-person computer workshops for older adults.
- 3. ESCOM Council is setting up a Vision Focus group to work with how ESCOM can be supportive of the Vision 2030 and document presented at the 2024 Fall Convocation.
- 4. ESCOM is planning a "Symposium on Healthy Aging" to take place on April 12, 2025. This is designed to replace the "Mini Medical School" offering that ended with COVID; many members have requested an event such as this.
