The environmental scan is a look at internal and external political, social demographic, market trends that will impact COM in the near future. Combining this with efforts to intentionally collect data for needs assessment will help inform our Mission review and development of the next Educational Master Plan (Fall 2024). Specifically, incorporate needs assessment data collection into existing efforts working with industry advisory groups and high school outreach activities. Potential opportunities to gather data include an April Counselors conference with counselors and College/Career Center staff; satellite course planning with Novato and San Marin high schools, potential dual-enrolled onsite offerings at IVC. In addition, we will look at existing data to support known challenges such as expanding ESL population in the Novato school district, and potential for maximizing community use of IVC facilities.</p> </div>
