- Employee Panel, Moderator and Panelists TBD
 - Staff have expressed an interest in learning more about the student support programs that exist at COM and the departments that manage them. Classified Senate agreed that a panel consisting of employees from different departments would be a good way for staff to get to know their colleagues and the services they provide.
- Student Equity for Non-Public-Facing Staff, Presenter TBD

 The Fall 2017 Equity Summit started some valuable conversations around student equity. However, staff who don't interact regularly with students would like to know more about how they can address student equity within their own position and department.

 Staff have indicated that they'd like to learn more about student equity in greater context.

 A theme that continues to arise from professional development day feedback is to have continued workshops on self-care, stress reduction, and exercise such as yoga or dance.  Feedback from the Spring 2017 classified professional development day included a request for a presentation on at least one of the following topics: Conflict Resolution; Communication; Strategies for Managing Frustration; Preventing Burnout
