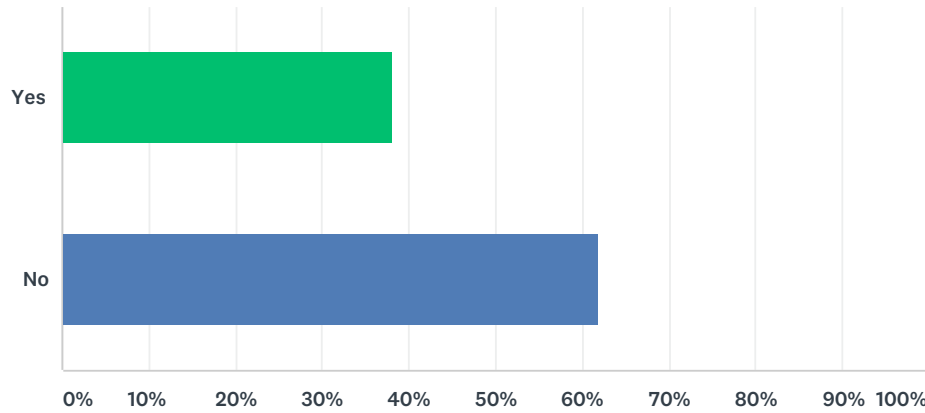

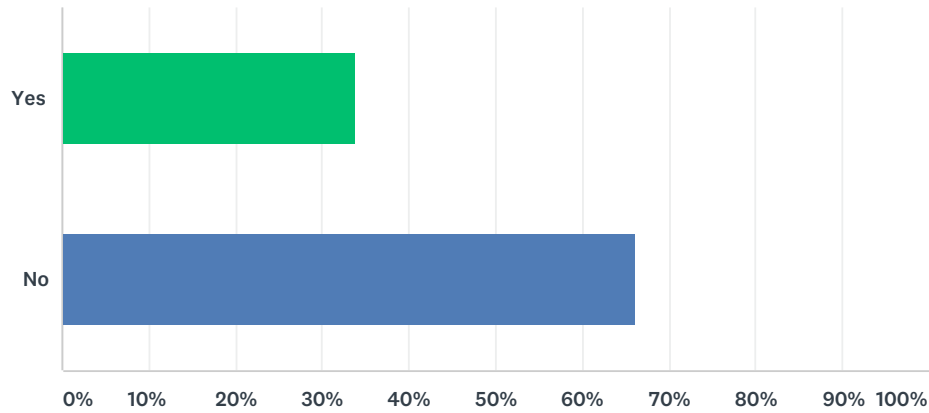

Q8 I completed online training that I found through ProLearning.

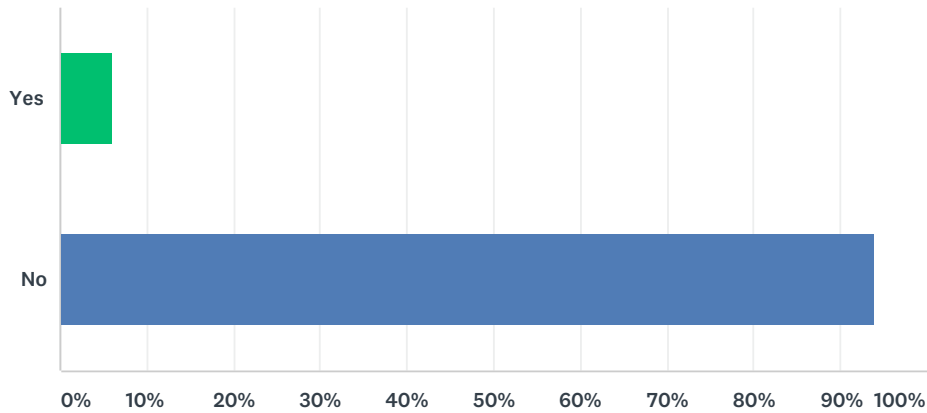

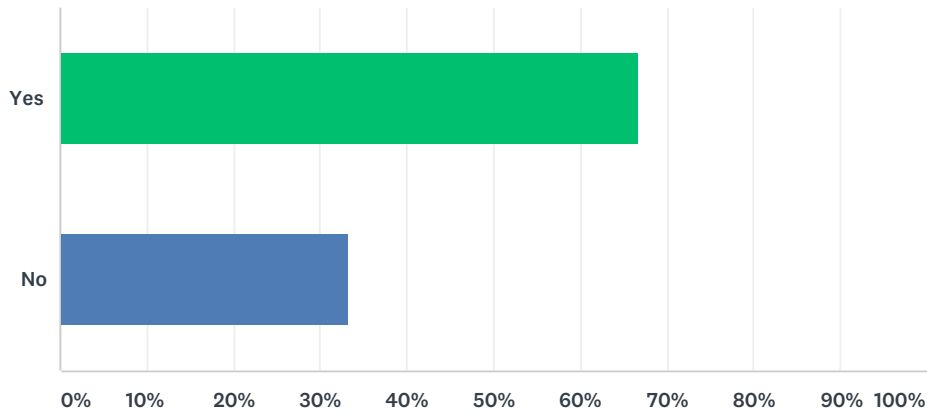

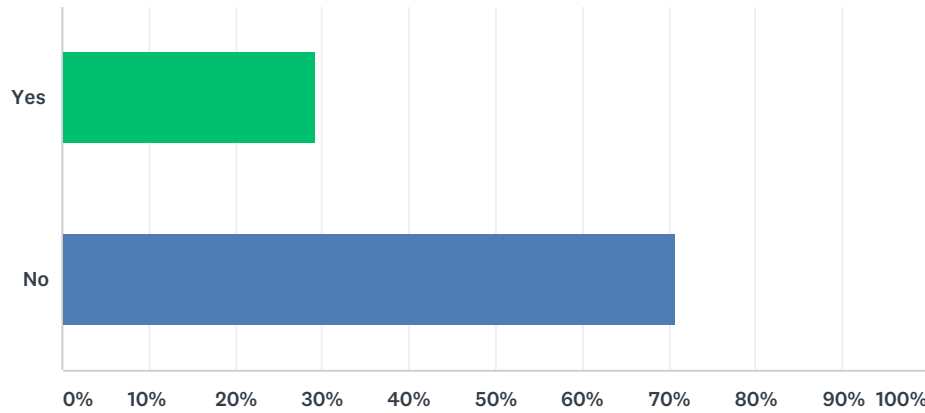

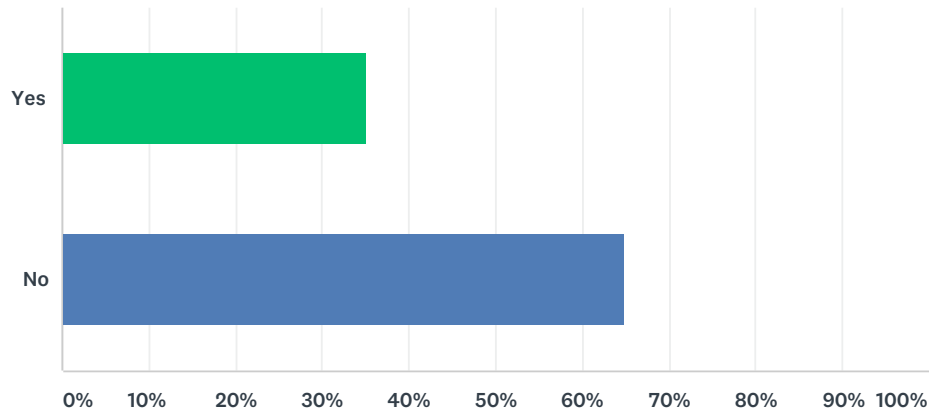

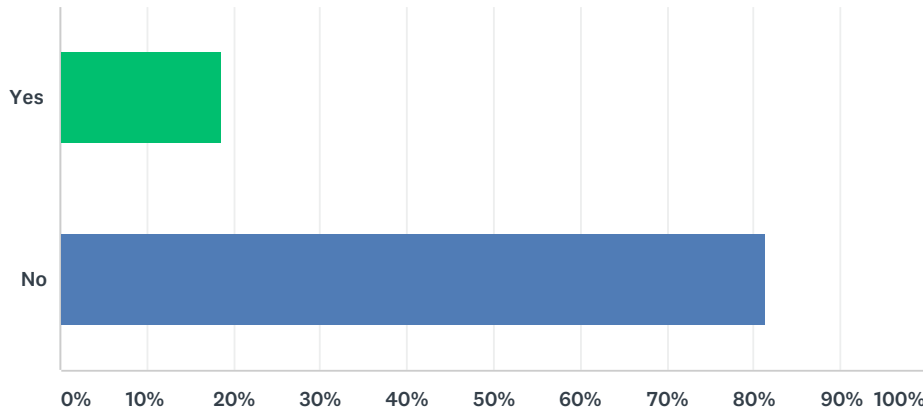
