Dear David:

Based on a recommendation from an anonymous fund, I am pleased to inform you that I have approved a grant to Marin Community College District. The terms of the grant are as follows:

Grant Purpose:

To fund Haddie Academic Scholarships for students at the College of Marin (\$100,000) and free/nominal fee courses (\$70,000) within the Emeritus College Program during 2016-2018

Grant Number:

2017-00044

Grant Amount:

\$170,000

Grant Period:

August 1, 2016 - June 30, 2018

*Criteria and Projects

Reports Due:

- (1) \$100,000:
- Mid-term report due June 1, 2017 Final report due June 1, 2018
- To fund the Haddie Academic Scholarship Fund through which eligible students receive \$1,000 per year to support the cost of course materials and supplies. The first \$500 installment is to be issued after the student formally agrees to spend scholarship funds in accordance with donor intent. The second \$500 installment is to be issued if the student's eligibility remains intact and the student's submitted receipts from the previous semester indicate compliance with donor intent. To be eligible to receive a Haddie Academic Scholarship, students must be enrolled in 9+ units/semester and maintain a 2.5+ GPA. BOG Waiver recipients are eligible, as are previous Haddie Academic Scholarship awardees.

- Mid-term report due June 1, 2017
- Final report due June 1, 2018

To provide funding to the Emeritus College to offer additional free or nominal fee courses during 2016-2018

*Please note that you will be required to submit a narrative and financial report on the use of the funds after they have been spent.
