a. PGS Survey for 2021:

**Number of Survey respondents:** A concern was raised that since the Survey results only showed around a 20% response rate, was it truly representative of the college as a whole. But it was also pointed out that 300+ part time faculty may not be participating in the PGS as much, so perhaps that might be a factor. Another concern was that the survey went out in Mid-November which could have been a factor. Perhaps in the future sending out the survey in Flex week might get a greater response.

**Who responded:** 53% of faculty, 30% of staff and 22% of administrators had never served on a committee;

**Positive v. Negative Comments:** It appears throughout that there were only two respondents who were extremely negative about governance.

**Specific recommendation:** the response was overwhelming in favor of allowing flexibility in running meetings – in person or on zoom or providing the option for both (75%).

**Suggestion for recruitment/advertising:** Perhaps at the end of Spring (and again at Flex) we could make a newsletter that explains what the various committees do/when they meet, how to get on a committee, and include some of the comments from the survey.

**Going forward:** We are all tasked with reading through the survey again – with the objective to synthesize what we find and find each of our top 3 important takeaways to share with the committee at our next meeting.
