Review of GRIT Committee Charge

- Participatory Governance Committees have been asked by Dr. Coon to review their charge in the context of equity. Members worked on a preliminary draft of the revised charge. Changes included adding anti-racist practices to the charge and the responsibilities and including dismantling anti-blackness to the responsibilities.

Committee Leadership

- Current chair invited members who were interested in chairing or co-chairing the committee in 2020/2021 to come forward. There were no volunteers and Tonya Hersch will continue as Committee Chair.

Proposals for Committee Fall 2020 Priorities and 2020/2021 Priorities

- Program Reviews, for both Instructional and Non-Instructional programs. GRIT will be evaluating the Institutional Outcomes for Non-Instructional programs; GRIT could develop guidelines for Non-Instructional Program review templates.
- Resource and technology issues for students, especially in the light of COVID 19.
- Review of success rates of classes to identify patterns of disproportionate impact.
- Students that have been lost since the onset of COVID 19.
- The Office of Planning and Research will be creating a Fall20 student survey. This survey could be designed to include information for a student needs assessment. P & R will also be reviewing enrollment data after the census date. The program review template contains disaggregated student success rates,

this information will available soon. The Chancellor's office has updated their disproportional impact data and this will also be available soon.

- Committee members agreed that this data will be helpful to Committee in developing priorities.
