## Student Equity Plan

- The focus of this meeting is Equity with regard to Student Supports and Services. Guests from Educational Success, Outreach, English, ESL, Math, Academic departments, Academic Senate, Tutoring & Learning, PRIE, Student Activities & Advocacy, Professional Learning, SAS, UEI, Umoja LC, Puente, MESA, and Mi Familia, Library, RWL, TLC were invited to participate in today's meeting.
- The Committee Chair updated gave an update on the Student Equity Plan and GRIT's role in its development and implementation to guests and member. They noted that the Student Equity Plan is a College wide collaboration and that these meetings are intended to increase awareness and foster collaborations and support for the activities of the Student Equity plan.
- Committee chair shared a spread sheet with the Chancellor's Office metrics, the disproportionally impacted student groups that the Student Equity Plan is focusing on, the activities in the SEP that address the disproportional impact and the offices and departments that support or direct these activities.
- Equity and Student Supports activities broken down by DI groups were reviewed and discussed by Guests
  and Members. The conversation included an in-depth discussion of the Equity and Mental Health
  activities, collaborations and partnerships including the Equity and Mental Health Symposium. A
  discussion of activities focused on enhancing collaborations and alignments within the Learning
  Communities and between the Learning Communities and Student Support Services and Resources was
  strongly supported by Members and Guests.
