Kinesiology Program Data (PRIE)

- **Enrollment**
 - Enrollment Success: Increased for male students
 - Enrollment Success by Modality: DI observed in Online/Async classes
 - Enrollment for Hispanic students: consistently low

- **Student Demographics**
 - First Year Students by Race/Ethnicity: no data for Black or African American students for Fall 2024

Recommendations

- Program Review: Remove transcriptions from the review to finalize and make it clearer
- Create an in-person section for health classes 115, 130, & 140 to broaden access for students
