  - Piloting Cornerstone PD software, much of the page is devoted to info about this new initiative

  - Very extensive Flex/pd program
  - Lots of info about their Center for Teaching Excellence – floor plans, procedures
- Cerritos College – <http://www.cerritos.edu/ic/>
  - Simple/clear
  - Easy to navigate
  - Less text, more pictures
  - Link to full pages
  - Good use of pictures
- Santa Rosa JC - <https://pd.santarosa.edu/welcome-professional-development>
  - Boring front page, used button “click to submit a flex proposal”
  - 8 main drop down menus from type – home, about us, professional development, flex-approved activities, PDA days, forms, resources, tuition reimbursement
- De Anza College – <http://www.deanza.edu/professionaldev/>
  - Text-heavy page, divided into three columns
  - Good information, could make more use of drop down menus
  - Everything fits on one main page, no scrolling necessary to see page

- San Diego Mesa College (LOFT – Learning Opportunities for Transformation) - <http://www.sdmesa.edu/about-mesa/professional-learning/>
  - Clean front page, pic of employees talking with each other in the LOFT
  - Three columns
  - Four main headings/links on left side – LOFT, training/events, resources, requests, CEL committee, Instructional design
  - Outstanding PL center – very well developed

  - Very clean/ simple
  - 5 main heading/drop-down menus – home, workshop registration, training opportunities, PD committees, about
  - Eye-catching graphics
