- **Flex Week January**
 - Review and discussion of Flex Week Proposals
 - A Dialog on UDL for STEM: suggestions to get more clarification on this proposal. Ask what types of examples? Have they consulted with Elle? Is information in alignment w/SAS principles? What is their definition of UDL?
 - Discover Contemporary Latinx...Painting: suggestion to refine the Session Outcomes. Clarify how to connect the content to the outcomes.
 - Pump Up Your Writing Prompts: discussion about inviting chairs to encourage faculty to attend this session. Suggestion to add another facilitator outside of English Dept.
 - Active Assailant Training: Danila /Aneissa will help support this. Also offer Lunch (is there PD funding?). Suggestion that focus be to Relax and Reflect Over Lunch – not necessarily a directed session.
 - Since there are many proposals: agreement to stack the sessions rather than move some to another day or Preflex Week. Possibly offer the popular sessions at another additional time to accommodate folks who could not attend during Flex Week.
 - Discussion regarding dual delivery sessions. Cara has reserved FH 110 for all of these sessions.
 - Land Acknowledgements: Dr. Coon and Angela Olmansen are reaching out to Dominican University & Coastal Miwok Coastal Tribal Council. They will be inviting others who identify as Native Americans into the discussion. PLC agrees to invite Dr. Coon to a PLC meeting to provide an update in the Spring.
