 - Accessibility is an issue that needs a bigger spotlight, more awareness of all that the issue encompasses.
 - Request for more tech training especially from faculty having to switch to remote learning
 - As the COVID drags on the importance of self-care and mental health workshops will increase
- **Professional Learning Plan** a new plan must be developed and submitted by Spring 2020.
