- Stormy – Thanks for creating a safe space to open up and have this discussion.
- Kristin – With the Advisory Committee, is this a part of PRAC or is it its own identity?
- Dr. Coon – Working with Chief and Greg Nelson to make sure the safety of our current police staff is taken into consideration.
 - Each recommendation will have a different timeframe; we don't know how long each will take.
 - We are looking at overall cost.
 - We will look at having a broader discussion (will this go to this Academic Senate or will this report directly to Dr. Coon?)
 - We are looking at what other districts are doing and what their charges are.
 - Dr. Coon and Jonathan will follow up to see how RRAC can help.
- Patricia – What happens when there are injuries on campus? What do you do if a student says they can't afford an ambulance?
 - Call 911 no matter what. Do not take this on. This is a liability and we have insurance to cover those who are hurt on our property, but cannot afford care.
- Lisa – One concern is for those who work late hours.
 - Having staff here late at night is helpful (evenings and weekend help would also be beneficial especially for those who have late classes and/or performances, recitals, rehearsals etc.)
 - Does this need to be an officer? Can it be other resources (ie. Ross police)
- Greg – District has reciprocity agreements (ie. Ross, Central Marin and City of Novato for IVC)

- If an officer isn't available, then someone from the local district will come.
- Priority code (1 is low and 5 is high), but often other resources like Ross PD don't know the campus as well as on-campus police/ employees here.
- Colleen – Senate is great to start with and maybe hosting focus group sessions.
