Reconnecting & Reviewing Fall Work

As a result of discussions at January Flex Sessions, a new meeting schedule has been developed that includes "Budget Answer Sessions" and other opportunities for PRAC to gather campus input to enhance its budget reduction work. Additional and extended meetings may also be necessary.

PRAC's "Budget Reduction Exercise" memo, dated 12/3/18, was reviewed, which delineates PRAC's ground rules and guiding principles for its budget reduction work.

Budget Assumptions, Part One - Greg

Discussion highlights:

- COM has the highest cost per FTE in the state \$16,177 in 2017-2018
- COM's median class size is 12 students
- Savings and/or revenue increase options to consider:
 - Reduction in Categorical program backfills
 - Application for more noncredit program federal grants

The updated 2018-2019 Adoption Budget was reviewed, including updated budget assumptions through 2021-2022.
