**Landscape Master Plan Updates – Isidro and Marco Esposito (SWA)**

SWA Architects was awarded the contract for the Landscape Master Plan. A committee has been created and they are working regularly on this project.

Highlights of the plan:

- All projects to be blended together – not stand alone
- Planting listing will be included in Plan
- More drought tolerant/native plants will be used
- KTD:
  - Create an outdoor sense of place
  - Maintain and redefine signature view facing Mt. Tam
  - Enhance arrival experience at Circle Drive and PE Complex
  - Develop promenade along creek

- IVC:
  - Bridges and sidewalks that are better marked and redesigned as “walkways”
  - Lawnsapes with more seating/meeting areas

### **Program Review Process External Review**

The new Program Review process has been implemented and is ongoing. In the six-year cycle, prior to a Program Review’s presentation to PRAC, it needs to be externally reviewed.

PRAC needs to develop a recommendation on how to that takes place. Jon will provide more information for review and discussion at future meetings.
