# Our Work

**Online Instruction** - development of online content and procurement of accessibility resources to support faculty, staff, and students

**Policies and Guidelines** – new policies around ICT; web page designed to serve as an accessibility guide and resource (i.e., accessible social media; procurement; accessible instructional design)

**Student Accessibility Services** - training, technical assistance, and support to faculty and staff in the provision of accommodations.
