Top Take Aways

- TPC endorsed proposal for AI Community of Practice to address fragmented AI implementation across campus
- ERP migration to cloud recommended, but Ellucian's SaaS product not yet ready; Dr. Conrad to negotiate cloud-hosted solution
- Microsoft is moving towards requiring multi-factor authentication for all access, potentially impacting on-campus logins
- Committee to continue work on College of Marin Technology Plan for Fall 2025

Certiport AI training updates

- Certiport training covers 9 AI applications.

Technology Plan Development

- Outline presented for 2025-2030 College of Marin Technology Plan
- Plan to align with educational master plan and State Vision 2030
- Dr. Conrad suggested including stakeholder feedback and surveys in plan development
- Committee endorsed exploring use of third-party consultant for survey administration

AI Community of Practice Proposal

- Stacey Lince submitted Strong Workforce funding proposal for AI Community of Practice
- Goals include creating AI Commons, developing guidelines, vetting tools, and providing professional learning
- Committee unanimously endorsed the proposal

ERP and Ellucian Update

- Current on-premises Banner ERP recommended for cloud migration
- Ellucian is pushing SaaS product, but Dr. Conrad advises against due to incomplete development
- Plan to negotiate cloud-hosted solution without changing current customizations
- Common ERP for all California community colleges discussed, but no suitable product currently available

Multi-Factor Authentication

- Microsoft is moving towards requiring MFA for all product access
- Currently only required for off-site access or security incidents
- Potential impact on on-campus logins in the future

Next Steps

- Dr. Conrad to meet with Ellucian to discuss cloud-hosted ERP solution
- Stacey to forward AI Community of Practice proposal to Dr. Conrad for signature
- Committee to reconvene in fall to continue work on Technology Plan
- Dr. Conrad to attend CIO meeting in August for Ellucian updates
- Heather to schedule a summer meeting with Dr. Conrad and Tessa for further discussions
