#### Discussion Items

1. Tech plan timeline
  - October 2025: launch surveys
  - November – January 2026: Draft and review report
  - Later January – February 2026: other committees review such as Academic Senate, EPC, CSEA, Student Senate, etc.
  - March – Spring Break 2026: Incorporate all feedback and reach a final draft
  - March/April 2026: Submit for final review with senior management
  - April 2026: Submit to Board of Trustees for final review
2. Survey questions for tech plan development
  - Structure and Content**
    - Reviewed draft questions for students, faculty, and staff
    - Discussed need to reduce number of questions, aiming for under 10 for students
    - Agreed to remove redundant questions and clarify language
    - Added specific tools and systems used by faculty and staff (e.g., Teams, Banner, SchoolDude)
  - Student-Specific Questions**
    - Focus on device usage, connectivity issues, and experience with Canvas
    - Include questions on biggest technology challenges and preferred course types

- Consider adding question on accessibility of resources and problem-solving

#### **Faculty and Staff Questions**

- Include questions on commonly used tools (e.g., Microsoft Suite, Adobe, Argos)
- Ask about training preferences and needs
- Consider questions on cybersecurity and readiness for new technologies

#### **Survey Distribution and Analysis**

- Student survey to be included in a broader student survey going out soon
- Aim for 25% response rate from students
- Plan to share results with student government for interpretation and feedback

#### **Next Steps**

- Dr. Conrad to revise and clean up survey questions
- Heather to review revised questions and distribute to committee for quick feedback
- Aim to get student questions to Holly by Tuesday next week for inclusion in survey
- Consider scheduling one more meeting before winter break to discuss report writing
- Explore using AI to assist in drafting the technology plan report
