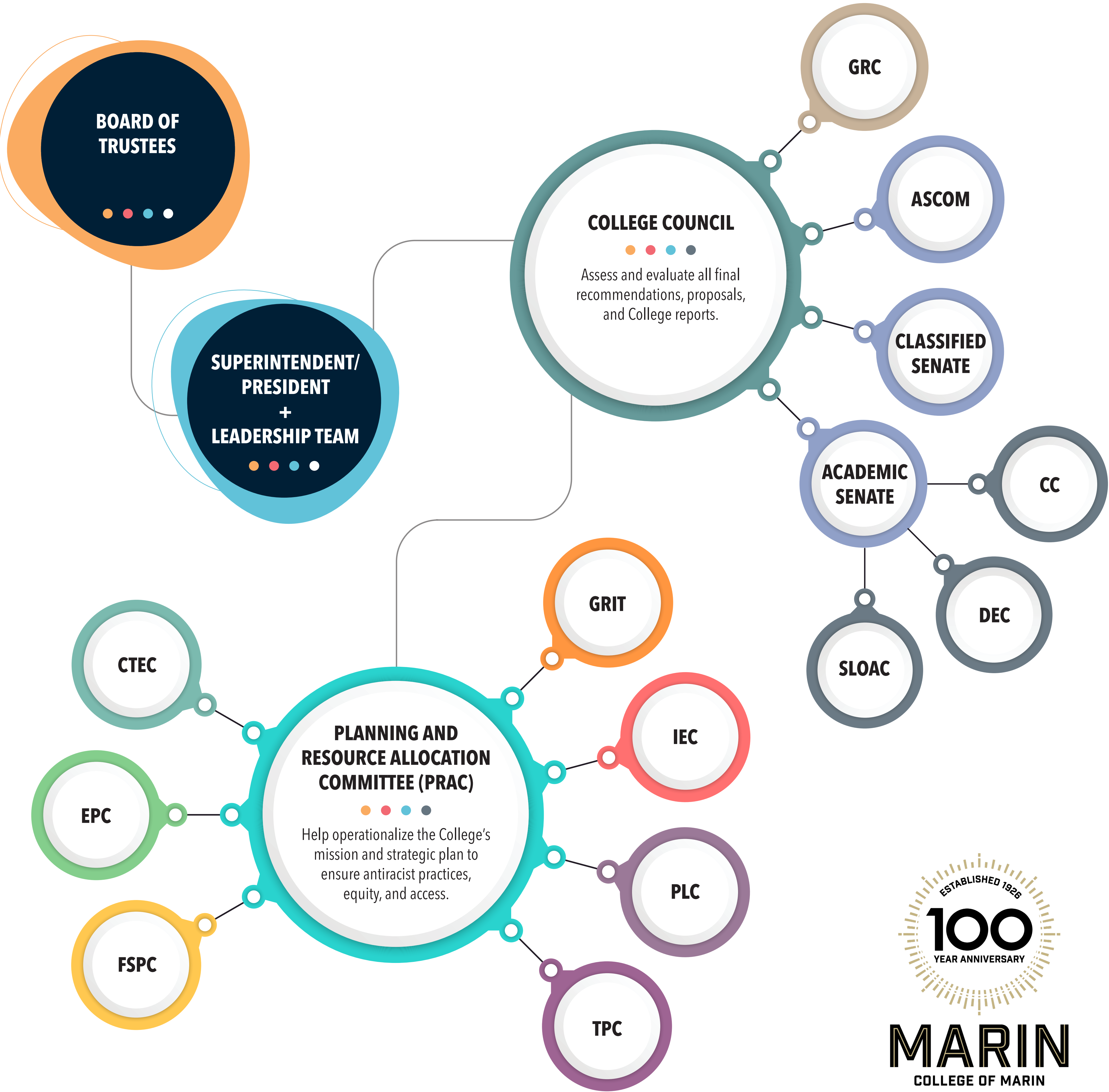


PARTICIPATORY GOVERNANCE SYSTEM
