IP Goal 2

EPC supports the self-evaluation of substantial progress. Progress on P.I. but may reflect changes in population of students due to pandemic (students diverted from 4-year school), so look next year to see if trend continues.

CER Goal 2

CER 2.1 and 2.2 - EPC supports the self-evaluation of substantial progress for objectives for CER Goal 2. P.I.s may reflect impact of pandemic, so look to see if trends continue in upcoming years. Recommendation from PRIE: Make time for Champions to look at P.I. data as they are writing narratives.

CER Goal 3

No self-evaluation has been included in the report. EPC Progress evaluation is Red for no progress due to pandemic. The pandemic prevented us from gathering information from the community. There are many reports out in the community addressing this issue. Nonprofits and county agencies are useful sources, but the pandemic is not over so a needs assessment will be difficult to do. If possible, collect pandemic impact reports from MCOE, Marin Promise, Marin Community Foundation, Canal Alliance, Marin Health Human Services, etc. This may be a potential partner: "[Reworking the Bay](#)"

Needs assessments may or may not have changed as we move out of pandemic; possible to see what exists but what is not represented in these reports to come together as a cohesive narrative.

CER Goal 4

Self-evaluation internal – Yellow - some progress

Self-evaluation external – Red – no progress

College responded well internally to student's needs. Helping with IT needs, financial needs and social emotional needs. Post-pandemic, focus on reengaging with students who are no longer with college or never enrolled, who have been disproportionately impacted by the pandemic. The executive/President's office may not be the best champions for this Goal. It might be better to have someone who is closer to the action.
